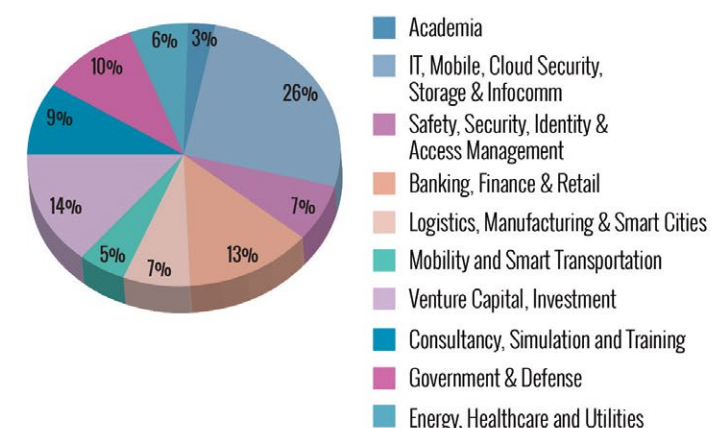

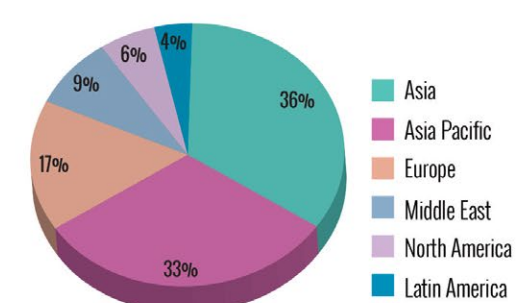

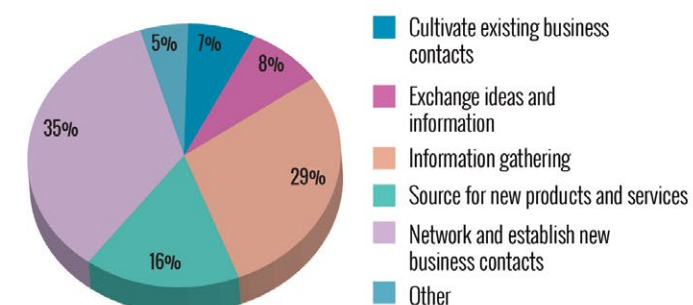
Main Business Activity



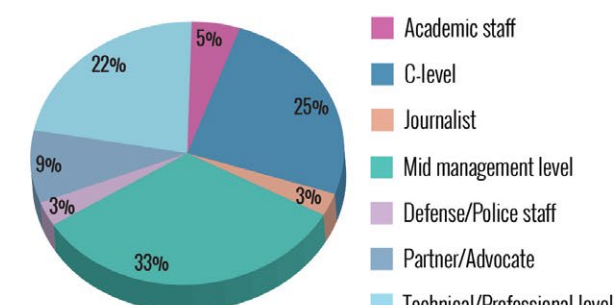
